We invite your kind attention to the reference cited, calling for suggestions and 1) objection in relation to raising of power tariff and surcharges.

2) Though you have been spending thousands of crores of rupees to purchase power, laying grids, sub-stations, lines etc., you are not appointing sufficient Line Men in the villages due to which in cases of breakdowns power is cut and no repairs are done immediately, accidents and deaths are occurring, collections of revenues is not done properly. There will be lot of saving of power and resolution of lot of problems, if one line man for one gram panchayat or 20 line men for one section are appointed.

As told by you, the allotment of the transformers is transparent, but all the works 3) like transportation of the material like poles, conductor, DTR, matching material, digging MEMBER (T) PESHI of pits, construction of platform etc are being done by farmers free of cost. The cost of all the works done by farmers are claimed by your contractor and officials. officials demand money from the formers at different rates for each of the works. This corruptive method also is transparent and open secret. The solution for this problem is that you only sanction transformer and permit the farmers to buy other matching material from outside companies on reimbursable basis. You reimburse for all the works done by the farmers for making the transformer operational. The reimbursement should be done by transferring the amounts directly to the accounts of the farmers.

of installing transformers should be given either to TATA or L&T companies and see that there are no pending applications as on date.

- About 6000 AB Switches and about 3000 Earthings in Mahabubnagar District are 5) not installed due to which many a no. of farmers are getting electrocuted and dying. Though deaths are many only some are reported in the press. Hence, the department should see that all transformers should have earthing and AB switches and SG Sets.
- There are many number of villages in the State especially in Mahabubnagar dist. 6) There is no power connection for the villages located around Vatavarlapalli. Hence, take action to provide power connection on war footing.
- The department/Corporation should see that bills are properly raised, replacement 7) of meters for any reason what so ever should be attended to immediately. All the consumer disputes are settled immediately. They should not be left unattended until the effected parties approach CGRF.
- It is learnt that Loss on account of Transmission of power from Genco to Transco 8) to Discom is estimated by you at 17%. If the loss of power from sub-station to domestic meters and AGL, and technical line loss and revenue loss is known, one can arrive at actual loss pertaining to AGL. The burden on AGL will be reduced. This loss should be reduced drastically to 4% as was done in Visakhapatnam. It is learnt that they have brought down the loss from 17% to 4%. There will be a huge saving of power.
