Sub: Objections / suggestions to the Public Notice regarding ARR filings and Tariff/Charges.

Ref: Public Notice issued by the TSSPDCL dated 10-03-2016, related to the filing of ARR and Tariff proposals including cross-subsidy surcharge proposals.

We, the VIRINCHI HEALTH CARE PRIVATE LIMITED hereby by would like bring to your notice that we are constructing a super-specialty hospital with bed strength of 500 at Road No.1, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad. We will very soon commence the hospital operations and the expected date of opening of hospital is 21-04-2016. We will treat large number of patients as Outpatients, and Inpatients in our hospital, we also have dedicated oncology block which provides highest standards of treatment to cancer patients. More than 70% of the patients would be Aarogyasri, EHS, Arogya Bhadrata, CGHS and other categories who are provided treatment at subsidize tariff prescribed by the Government. At any given point of time about hundred patients will be treated in Intensive care units and all of them require continuous round the clock monitoring, ventilatory support and multi organ support care. Frequent interruptions and voltage fluctuations in power supply will cause serious problems for these patients inspite of the UPS and generator backup that we have.

We request you to kindly consider these facts and review the recently issued public notice for tariff policy (dated 10/03/2016) given by the Southern power distribution company of Telangana Limited. (TSSPDCL).

- 1. We request you to shift, hospitals from the HT 2 category to HT 6 category and provide preferential tariff. A separate category for Hospitals, at preferential tariffs is preferred.
- 2. Since Hospitals work on a 24 hour basis, we request relief from Time of Day Tariffs.
- 3. Since the hospitals cater to the needs of a large number of sick patients on ventilators and monitors we request you to provide uninterrupted power supply.



4. We request you to permit to avail open access without the burden of cross subsidy charges.

In view of the above, we object for the proposed hike in the tarrif, further we request you to consider re categorization and reduction in tarrif.

Request you to kindly grant us a chance to be heard in person.
